This position is ideal for a **bi-vocational minister**, a recent graduate seeking preaching experience, or a retired minister who desires to continue serving in a congregational setting.

Congregational Profile

Community

Burlington is a rural agricultural community of approximately **3,500 people** and serves as the county seat. Members travel from Burlington and surrounding towns up to 40 miles away. The area offers public, Catholic, and Christian schools, a community college, and strong community support through local ministries and organizations.

Ministry Expectations

- Preach **three Sundays per month**
- Teach Bible classes as needed
- Maintain office hours approximately **½ day per week**
- Provide pastoral care as schedule allows
- Work under the direction of the men of the congregation and participate in men's meetings
- Encourage and support existing ministries, including:
 - Children's Bible classes
 - Community meals and outreach
 - Assisted living and nursing home devotionals

- Youth participation in events such as **Soul Quest at York College**

Desired Qualifications

- Commitment to **sound New Testament teaching**
- Ability to work effectively within a **congregational leadership structure**
- Heart for ministering to people in a small-church, relational setting
- Willingness to help the congregation grow spiritually and explore appropriate outreach opportunities
- Appreciation for the unique opportunities and challenges of rural ministry

Compensation & Time Off

- Compensation up to **\$1,500 per month**
- Position is understood to be **part-time / bi-vocational**
- Time off includes:
 - **Four weeks of vacation**
 - **One week additional for personal growth** (study or lectureships)
 - **One week additional for planning and preparation**
