We're passionate about leading middle and high school students to love God with their whole hearts and be transformed by the power of the Holy Spirit in their lives. It's our goal to equip them to live lives that honor and reflect Christ so that they might reach others for His glory.

Through Bible studies, worship services, small groups, service projects, and special events like camps and retreats, we point teenagers toward God's love and guide them to understanding the huge plan He has for their lives.

In everything we do, we always point our youth towards the mission of knowing Christ, growing together, serving others, and sharing with the World.

Job Description



The Youth Minister is responsible for developing a comprehensive youth ministry that is consistent with the ministry of the church. He works closely with the Bellevue shepherds, youth deacons, staff, and parents to develop and grow a ministry that seeks to equip, enrich, and engage each student in their spiritual development and growth.

Qualifications

- Is a Biblically based and spirit-filled Christian.
- Has completed the necessary educational courses or the equivalent to lead in the area of youth ministry.
- Has at least two years working with youth in a ministerial role.

Responsibilities to Youth

Teaching Responsibilities

- Plan and coordinate a Biblical curriculum that addresses the spiritual and growth needs of our students in collaboration with the Bellevue shepherds, youth deacons, staff, and parents
- Teach class regularly on Sundays and Wednesdays
- Recruit additional teachers to facilitate classes on Sundays, Wednesdays, and at special events

Ministry Responsibilities

- Plan and coordinate small groups, retreats, service projects, Bible camps, devotionals, and mission efforts to promote faith development in our teens
- Equip and encourage students to participate in leadership roles in ministry activities and assemblies
- Connect with other ministries at Bellevue
- Grow and maintain parental and member involvement through open communication
- Work with the Nest (after school program for local middle school students) – to develop relationships with the students and encouragement to be part of the BYG.
- Assist in coordinating Youth Connect on Sunday evenings under oversight of assigned deacons, leading the 6th through 12th grade small group.
- Attend the annual Lads to Leaders convention with those youth who participate.

Job Description



Administrative Responsibilities

- Attend and participate in weekly Bellevue staff meetings
- Attend shepherd meetings when needed
- Work with youth deacons to prepare, maintain, and work within an annual BYG expense budget availability of \$20K-\$25K which is funded annually through a special contribution from the membership
- Oversee BYG facilities and equipment
- Participate in an annual performance evaluation with the shepherds

Relational Responsibilities

- Serve as a role model, mentor, and encourager for our students
- Invest in a personal relationship with Jesus, your family, and the Bellevue family
- Be engaged in church-wide activities to foster a healthy connection to the church family

Personal Qualities and Attributes

- The youth minister should possess the gifts and capabilities for building relationships with students and their families, for skillful teaching of God's word in ways relevant to teenagers, and for leadership of a spiritually formative youth ministry program.
- The youth minister should be a strong self-motivator, able to take initiative in the development and leadership of the youth program.
- The youth minister should be a capable communicator, able to coordinate with parents and volunteers about plans and opportunities to serve.

Other Duties as appropriate and as assigned - There may be other duties that are not described in this job description that from time to time may be required as directed by the eldership.
