Pastor of Children and Youth Ministries Salaried

General Purpose of Position:

Make young disciples for Christ by directing Children's and Youth Ministry Programs that enhance the overall ministries of the FCC.

Organizational Relationship and Supervision:

The Youth Minister will be under the guidance and of the Senior Pastor and report to Elders regarding monthly activities and plans. Board and Elder approval for large budget items is generally required. An annual review will be implemented by the senior pastor, and members of elders and board.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Oversee the planning, development, and implementation of Kids ministry including Children's Church Service, Sunday School and other programs which will help grow our kids and our church.
- Plan, develop, and implement a balanced Jr. & Sr. High youth ministry. This will include aspects of outreach, discipleship, and leader development. It will also include running a youth ministry program on Wednesday or Sunday evening.
- Recruit and train volunteers in the areas of Children's Ministry and Youth Ministry to ensure adequate volunteer support and adult to youth ratios
