Program Highlights

- 58-credit-hour program with students attending classes full time

Prerequisites

- 3 semester hours of sociology or cultural anthropology
- · 3 semester hours of general psychology
- 3 semester hours of lifespan development or developmental psychology (lifespan)
- · 3 semester hours of ethics or bioethics
- · 2 semester hours of nutrition
- 4 semester hours of general chemistry
- · 4 semester hours of microbiology
- · 4 semester hours of anatomy
- · 4 semester hours of physiology
- · 3 semester hours of statistics

Prerequisite courses can be taken at any accredited college or university and can be preapproved. Prerequisite courses must be completed with a C grade (2.0) or better by the start date of the Accelerated Nursing Program.
