## Program Highlights

- 58-credit-hour program with students attending classes full time
  - Coursework in critical thinking, clinical decision-making, professional communication skills, strong theoretical knowledge and clinical skills
- 900+ clinical hours
  - Specialties covered include: medical/surgical, obstetrics, labor and delivery, pediatrics, psychiatric/mental health, critical care and community/population health
- Active learning environment with flipped classroom strategies
  - Five 8-week terms, one 2-week intensive and one 3-week intensive

## Prerequisites

- 3 semester hours of sociology or cultural anthropology
- 3 semester hours of general psychology
- 3 semester hours of lifespan development or developmental psychology (lifespan)
- 3 semester hours of ethics or bioethics
- 2 semester hours of nutrition
- 4 semester hours of general chemistry
- 4 semester hours of microbiology
- 4 semester hours of anatomy
- 4 semester hours of physiology
- 3 semester hours of statistics

*Prerequisite courses can be taken at any accredited college or university and can be preapproved. Prerequisite courses must be completed with a C grade (2.0) or better by the start date of the Accelerated Nursing Program.*
